## 2005 Where's Molly Rosé

**THE WINE:** One of the best features of a high quality rosé is brilliant colour that looks even better in the glass. Shades of crimson sweet pea, coral, and an intense sunset pink sparkle as this wine is swirled. An immediate and seductive perfume of summer berry fruits and strawberry entice. The palate is naturally balanced with lively, zesty acidity complimenting crushed strawberries and watermelon. This vintage is a blend of 90% Cabernet and 10% Shiraz.

**STORY:** Molly and Elly are amiable German Shorthaired Pointers that greet visitors to our winery. However, every winery has a myriad of secret hidey-holes, and Molly, now into her second decade, knows them all. So when the cry of "Where's Molly?" goes up, she emerges in her own sweet time from one or another of them.

**WINERY:** Produced by the saignée method, the juice is soaked on skins for less than two days, creating the gorgeous pink hues. The juice is then pressed away from the skins and fermented in stainless steel tanks.
