# Maxwell 2006 G & T Grenache Tempranillo

## TASTING NOTE

### THE NAME

The winery staff simply referred to this blend as the "G & T" throughout vintage, so the name stuck.

### THE VINTAGE

The growing season was fairly mild, with several rain showers in December and January creating concern regarding vine disease. However minimal and well-timed spray programmes avoided any damage. White varieties looked particularly lively with great flavours, while flavour ripeness in the reds occurred at lower sugar levels compared to previous years. Resultant wines are showing very rich, powerful and concentrated flavours without excessive alcohol or jamminess.

### THE WINE

Bottled and released in its youth, this blend is a vibrant wine with brilliant purple hues matched by intense raspberry and spice aromas. The perfectly weighted palate delivers fresh red berry flavours wrapped in subtle tannin, while a spicier undertone weaves and entices... Enjoy this wine with fresh food and good company.
