Molly is a mature-age German Shorthaired Pointer. THE WINE

This wine has an amazingly brilliant shades of crimson sweat-pea and a pinky-red sunset that simply sparkle when swirled in the glass. An immediate and ripe perfume of summer berry fruits and strawberry entice, with the palate offering sweet fruit and refreshing watermelon with a balanced, lively finish.
