## Vintage Conditions

Geographically intertwined with the Tamar Valley, the Pipers River region is renowned for its cool maritime climate and pristine landscapes, producing some of Australia's most highly regarded sparkling wines. Our vineyard is situated at the foothills of Mount Arthur, the cool climate, influenced by the proximity to Bass Strait, along with high sunshine hours imparts a distinct elegance to the wines and is an idyllic site for Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, and Chardonnay.

## Colour & Aroma

The colour is bright and clear. Highly aromatic, red strawberry and cherries fill the bouquet.

## Palate

Vibrant red fruits on the palate, light on its feet and a delicious red for summer.
